Costs of house in these cities have gone through roof and out of reach of general public. Property boom has already resulted in making only few people, engaged in construction business, extra rich at the cost of consumers whose rate of increasing income is lagging behind rate of inflation by a big margin. Inflation is the biggest worry for any government organizing this type of event and is also the most dangerous side effect. People have to face the consequences and many essential items used mostly by number of poor people become costlier and unaffordable for them. In the name of development, people given responsibility to spend public money spend it lavishly and we have seen during these megaevents that in some cases, in some countries, big amounts were spend in the name of renovation where good, strong and quality structures were brought down and same or even poor quality of structures were re-erected in its place thus wasting billions of dollars, energy, manpower, water and other resources and also resulted in increasing pollution, which could have been saved otherwise.
